The Medical Officer of Health (MOH) North Zone carries out responsibilities under the Alberta Public Health Act related to investigation and control of communicable diseases, infection prevention and control, injury prevention, and environmental threats to the health of all Albertans.

The MOH assesses potential risks to public health and takes steps to reduce or eliminate any risks by enforcing vital public health legislation, providing direction to staff, and advising and consulting with physicians and other healthcare providers on communicable disease control. You will work in partnerships to manage outbreaks and participate in the development, testing, and implementation of the province's emergency/disaster response program and collaborate with local government and agencies regarding public health programs and services.

The MOH role offers excellent flexibility as it now allows you to work remotely anywhere in Alberta. If working remotely is of interest, it will remain crucial to develop local partnerships and collaborate with key zone stakeholders to effectively address unique challenges and opportunities.

Work as the physician partner of Public Health Directors, Zone Leadership, and Managers in public health matters. Liaise with external partners such as municipalities, councils, and schools. Participate in public health research as requested. Teach learners and health practitioners public and population health principles and practices. Participate in on-call services to respond to all public health situations.

Required Qualifications:

Doctor of Medicine (MD). Licensed or eligible for licensure by the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Alberta (CPSA).

Demonstrated ability to develop and maintain strategic relationships with key stakeholders, agencies, patients and interdisciplinary colleagues that span municipal, provincial and federal governments to achieve population health goals.

Preferred Qualifications:

Fellowship with the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (RCPSC) in Public Health and/or Preventive Medicine (or equivalent). Residents in their final year of an eligible training program will be considered. Other combinations of post-graduate education and experience in public health will be considered.
